HELI will include two Mock Grant Review Sessions focused on your NIH or other research proposals that are very close to completion or already complete. If your proposal is chosen for review, you will be asked to share your proposal for review and feedback from other scholars and an expert review panel. This year we will identify 2 proposals for review, but there will be two review formats: (1) One review will follow the typical NIH-style session review with a panel of expert reviewers from campus and a session facilitator. The session will be facilitated by a HELI faculty who will engage with the Primary and Secondary reviewers, as well as a method consultant. This session will introduce the NIH Mock study section format (2) One review will be conducted by a Community Advisory Board (CAB) based in Milwaukee. These experts conduct reviews of research ideas and protocols through a community group meeting format in which the study PI provides a short presentation of his/her research and the CAB members then engage in a discussion about how the proposed study could be implemented from a community perspective. We will make copies of the proposal narrative to give to scholars and reviewers before the Mock Session. This would be done with the expectation that scholars would not duplicate these or share with others. We require a copy of the research proposal narrative no later than Friday, May 6th (if you need additional time, please contact Caitlin Scott at cscott8@wisc.edu).
